

MUSEUM PUBLIC NOTICE

The Millmerran & District Historical Society Inc. operates the Millmerran Museum and is currently undertaking a revision and update of its Collection Policy. The Society can no longer accept and can no longer keep items on loan. Many items were loaned in the early years of the establishment of the Museum. The Millmerran & District Historical Society Inc. hereby gives notice to persons who have loaned an item to the Museum to rightfully claim and then collect the item under the following criteria:

- (1) The claimant to show proof of identity.
- (2) The claimant to give a written description of the item – for example: size, its use, materials it was made from, age, colour, owner, any identification plate details and any supporting information about the object e.g. a newspaper article or in the case of a deceased estate a copy of the Will showing the beneficiary of the item.
- (3) The claimant to provide a photograph of the item or provide the Museum's receipt which was issued at the time of the item being presented to the Museum.
- (4) The claimant to provide a year in which the item was loaned and the name of the person who loaned the item in the first instance.
- (5) The claimant of any subject items to collect the item from the Museum no later than the 13th October 2026.
- (6) Any items that have not been claimed by 13th October 2026 will be deemed to have been gifted to the Museum.
